

Volunteers Wanted!

The Preventive Cardiology Department is conducting a research study to examine the effects of a study drug (ETC-1002) on cholesterol levels in people currently taking statins.

To volunteer you must be:

- A male or female between 18 and 80 years of age
- Currently taking a daily dose of one of the following statins:
 - atorvastatin (Lipitor) 10 mg or 20 mg
 - o simvastatin (Zocor) 5 mg, 10 mg, or 20 mg,
 - o rosuvastatin (Crestor) 5 mg or 10 mg, or
 - o pravastatin (Pravachol) 10 mg, 20 mg, or 40 mg
- Willing to have blood drawn and have an LDL-C level between 115 and 220
- Able to come to Hartford Hospital for study visits
- Post-menopausal or surgically sterile (if female)
- Willing to use birth control or have had a vasectomy (if male)

Participants who finish the entire study will be compensated \$675 for their time
